Tasks:

Gardening Volunteers will help improve sites in Maidstone Town Centre as part of the 'Green Spaces' initiative funded by Maidstone Borough Council and the Government's Shared Prosperity Fund.

Guided by the Horticultural Therapist, volunteers will work together to complete tasks in public places and parks such as, site clearing and litter picking, planting seasonal flowers, bulbs and trees, pruning trees and shrubs, maintaining planting beds and general upkeep of spaces.

This role is for those who are interested in gardening and want to be part of making Maidstone a cleaner and greener place to live.

All training and equipment will be provided.
