Kent & Medway Carers' Emergency Card

As a carer, you may worry about what will happen to the person you care for if you suddenly become ill or were in involved in an accident.

This recognised Carers Card means that should something happen to you, a person close to you will be contacted to ensure the person you care for is supported whilst you receive care.

Involve will supply you with an Emergency Plan to complete alongside this and can assist you to fill it out if needed.
